Campus safety

Speed limit

The 20 miles per hour (mph) speed limit on campus is there for pedestrian and cyclist safety. Please keep to this limit when you drive on site.

Parking

All cars must display a current parking permit within their vehicle, which can be obtained from main reception.

Only park in the designated car parking areas.

- Shout 'FIRE' and sound the alarm by activating the nearest fire alarm call point
- ✓ Evacuate the building by the nearest fire exit
- X Do not stop to collect personal belongings
- X Do not use passenger or goods lifts
- From a safe location contact Security on ext. 2222 or on 01234 752999 from a mobile. Security will send a patrol officer to the building and call the fire service
- ✓ Report to the assembly point
- X Do not re-enter the building until authorised to do so

Fire alarms are tested weekly. Your host will advise you if testing is to be carried out during your visit.

All visitors should report to main reception (building 26 – telephone **01234 750111**) on arrival at the University unless previously advised otherwise by your host.

If you are to be left unaccompanied, even for short periods, your host must explain and show you the specific fire evacuation procedure for the building you are in. Always take note of the fire escape routes and emergency exits for the area you are located.

Reducing risks and reporting

Electrical equipment

Please ensure that any electrical equipment brought onto site is in a safe and suitable condition.
